

Aqua Skiers Codes and Guidelines for Excellence

1. Becoming a member is a commitment to the team. Make every effort to be at all practices and shows on time and with the proper costumes and equipment needed.
2. Members must also join USA Water Ski (USA WS) and the Wisconsin Water Ski Federation (WWSF).
3. All members must know and follow NSSA rules before, during and following shows and practices. SAFETY FIRST.
4. Drug, alcohol or tobacco use is NOT appropriate while participating in (during) shows or practices.
5. Be a team player. Sportsmanship and integrity are fundamentals of this team.
6. Respect your show director, show committee, your teammates, your opponents and your officials.
7. Take proper care of all equipment and costumes to ensure that we will have them for many years of use.
8. We will strive to continue to be a source of pride within our community.
9. We are a volunteer organization but each member is expected to assist with the work of the team.
10. Members are encouraged to use the "Skier Delegates" to convey concerns, ideas etc to the Board of Directors
11. Encourage your teammates to do their best. Share your talents with teammates.
12. The Board of Directors will strive to keep members informed.
13. The Board of Directors will strive to be fiscally responsible.
14. All members will have an opportunity for input on decision making.
