

The Aqua Skiers Show Team is a volunteer organization. Each family and/or single adult participant is expected to assist with the volunteer work. It is a commitment that ensures a positive experience for all. Below is the Work hours Volunteer Policy.

Club Board of Director /Officer Volunteers

The Aqua Skiers, Inc. meets monthly to determine policy and the direction for the club. Board includes:

State Tournament Director

Though not required, Board members are encouraged to serve for at least two years to provide continuity to the club. Board Members will be exempt of Club dues (USA Water Ski and WWSF are still required).

Our two biggest fundraisers are the 4th of July event and the Wisconsin State Water Ski Show Tournament so most requirements will be at these two events.

Every family and/or single adult member is expected to fulfill the following:

4th of July

4 hours per family member up to a total of 16 hours max.

State Tournament

✓ All club members are asked to help with setup, which starts the Saturday preceding the start of the tournament and the teardown which starts Sunday after the end of awards at the tournament thru Wednesday of the following week.

Working of the Tournament itself the requirements will be as follows:

5 hours per day per member or 20 hours in four days

*Children 10 and under 3 hours max under direct adult supervision

You must be signed up for the work and then sign in/out the day of completion.

Non Fundraiser Volunteer Hours

A minimum of 20 hours per member or 40 hours per family is expected.

Any extra hours volunteered will be counted as \$\$\$ toward Aqua Skier dues for the following year.

The following is a list of non fundraiser volunteer options.

Serve on the Board (4 hours per month, may not be used for the rest of the family)

Setting and removing river docks.

Setting and removing river jump

Maintenance of river site including weed whacking, mowing, and other yearly items

Maintenance of Shed and surroundings

This is not a complete list and anytime a cleanup is called for hours may be registered.

Family work hours will be tracked by the Volunteer Coordinator; who will also determine what volunteer work qualifies for the hours.

Boat Drivers will be given volunteer hours for maintenance of their boats and trailers throughout the year.

Families and/or single members who do not fulfill their required volunteer hours will be assessed a fee of \$10 per hours not served and will be required to pay this assessment prior to renewing membership for the following year.
